

Top Ten Things
You and Your Student Should Know
About the Braille Sense Plus

1. For sighted teachers, a **<blank>** **<blank>** of the Braille Sense Plus can be found at http://www.gwmicro.com/images/braille_sense/braille_sense_plus.jpg
2. You can adjust the voice with the following keystrokes:
 - a. **<blank>**-F1 will decrease the volume. BACKSPACE-F4 will increase the volume.
 - b. SPACE-F1 will decrease the rate. **<blank>**-F4 will increase the rate.
 - c. **<blank>**-F1 will decrease the tone. ENTER-F4 will increase the tone.
3. You can turn the **<blank>** on or off by pressing BACKSPACE-F2.
4. You can toggle the LCD display on or off by pressing DOTS 4-5-6-**<blank>**.
5. You can access the Program menu at any time by pressing **<blank>**.
6. If you are in an application, and you want to access the menu for that application, pressing **<blank>** or SPACE-M will open the menu.
7. You can access the Options menu at any time by pressing **<blank>**.

- a. Once in the Options menu, you can change any of the options by pressing SPACE or BACKSPACE.
 - b. You must press ENTER in the Options menu to save the changes.
8. You can toggle One-handed Mode on or off by pressing <blank>.
9. To open an application, press <blank> on it.
10. When in the File Manager, press ENTER on a drive to open it. To get out of the list of folders in the drive, press <blank>.
